

## 1. CLUB INFORMATION

Hanging Limb Hunting Club is located in Overton county Tennessee north east of Monterey. This Club consists of approximately 2700 leased acres. This club was founded in 2017 by two original members, and is run and managed by these members and their designated managers. The purpose of this Club is the pursuit of all of the Hunting and Fishing Sports, and the quiet enjoyment of these activities. All other sports and activities are secondary to these.

It is understood that the Founding Members of this Club have the right to reject, accept or terminate these applicants at their discretion with no recourse by the applicant or member for the rejection or dismissal of said applicant.

Membership will run annually April 1<sup>st</sup> thru March 31<sup>st</sup>. No dues will be refunded to members that are terminated for breach of club rules or hunting violations. Terminated members have no recourse to recover lost dues.

## 2. MEMBERSHIPS & DUES

Membership dues are due before February 1 of each year. Any member whose dues are not paid by February 1 will be considered to have an open membership and may be replaced by a new member at the discretion of the management. The management has the right to adjust the membership dues amount at their discretion. (New Members and, or existing Members may **NOT** Hunt until Dues are paid in Full.)

## 3. CAMP RULES

- a. Members and their non-hunting guest are always welcome, but are expected to act in an orderly and reasonable manner. A paid member must accompany Guest on the property at all times. Any improper actions by a guest are considered to be actions by the member.
- b. Vehicles and trailers should be parked in the designated areas and all efforts made to not block other members and their vehicles. The camp grounds or sheds are NOT yearlong personal storage areas. Corn/Bait shall only be stored in a rodent/animal proof container.
- c. All campers will be put in the designated areas.
- d. No permanent structures are allowed to be constructed in or around member's campers. (Existing structures as of 4/1/2018 are exempt and allowed to remain as long as the owner remains a member.)
- e. Fires are allowed only on prepared areas, no fires allowed in hunting areas.
- f. **All trash, cans, bottles, etc must be disposed of properly; all trash must be removed from the hunting areas. If you bring it in you must take it out. Member's camp area and used common areas MUST be clean with NO trash left on the ground daily. All trash and feed bags must be secured in vehicle when traveling on the public roads. No trash may be left in hunting areas or around stands.**
- g. All camping items (ax, chainsaw, cooler, tools, small grills, ect.) must be stored in such a manner that it is not easily stolen. These items should not be seen from the road and hidden from sight.

- h. All Guns should be unloaded before you reach camp, remove shells and clips and caps on Muzzle loaders.
- i. Pistols and sidearms under the personal control of the Wearers are exempt.
- j. Social drinking is permissible, anyone drunk and or unruly will be asked to leave the club grounds. Drinking or drug use while gun handling or hunting will not be tolerated and may cause the termination of your membership.
- k. All campers/RV's MUST be unplugged from the electric when the member is not present during hunting/camping.

#### **4. ROAD RULES, ATVS, ETC.**

- a. Four-wheel drive vehicles are to be used on the club roads only during good weather.
- b. ATVS can be used in any weather on all roads.
- c. ATVS can be used to place stands or to remove animal kills or do club work.
- d. ATVS are not to be used for joy riding or racing.
- e. Do not drive ATVS through or over food plots.
- f. ATVs must have Club ID attached to it in a visible location.
- g. Any ATV being stored in any camp area should be covered or hidden from site to reduce thief of the entire camp. Each member is responsible for their own items if stolen.
- h. ATVs are not to be stored year around at the camp.

#### **5. HUNTING RULES & REGS**

- a. All TWRA, State or Federal rules and regulations and seasons apply.
- b. Immediate family members (Wife, son, daughter, father, mother, brother, sister) may hunt under a paid club membership. Not to exceed five hunts per year.
- c. A Non-Hunting spouse membership allows a members spouse to camp with the member the entire membership year. The members spouse must sign the Club rules and releases also.
- d. All Hunting Guest must sign Club rules and releases before hunting. Non family members are only allowed 1 hunt per year with a member.
- e. Each member will be added to the owners hog permit. Each member must report all hogs taken before December 31.
- f. Dogs may NOT be used for any hunting or running of game.
- g. Hogs traps are allowed. Only one trap per member. The size of the trap shall not be larger than 4'X8' enclosure. The trap must be personally checked every 24 hours. When not in use the trap must be locked

open or closed. The trap must have a Club ID on it. **Not checking the trap personally every 24 hours will be grounds for membership termination.**

- h. Hunting Stands shall not be a permanent structure. Tree stands are allowed as long as it is removable. All stands or blinds must have a Club ID attached to it.
- i. All carcasses shall be disposed of properly. A minimum of 1000 feet from any camp, public right of way, or road.

## **6. PERSONAL SAFETY**

All members agree and affirm that they are responsible for their own safety and conduct and personal property while on the Club property.

All members agree and affirm that they are solely liable for any loss or damage of personal property, or any incident that results in bodily injury or death to themselves, minors or guest in their party.

All members agree and affirm that they will hold harmless Hanging Limb LLC, its founders, managers, members, and all Owners of land leased by the club, for any loss or injury occurring on these properties.

All members are required to practice gun safety, use safety-climbing gear, and operate ATVS in safe manner. Use required PFDS while on the water.

All members should carry a cell phone and personal FRS OR GMRS radio. Please carry all emergency phone numbers or personal medical information on your person.

All members encountering trespassers should make an effort to identify these persons or Get tag numbers. DO NOT JEOPARDISE YOU SAFETY, report all incidents to the club managers.

**Any member that does not follow the Club Rules and/or has complaints filed against them for non compliance, will be issued one (1) written warning and the second offence maybe termination of membership.**
